Upon arrival please check in at the porters lodge where you will be directed to the conference centre to register for the meeting and collect your delegate pack.

Travel to Oxford:

Rail

Oxford is on the main line between Birmingham and London and is accessible from most major towns. Trains run at least once an hour between Oxford and London, and twice an hour during peak times. Oxford is also on the main cross-country routes.

Oxford train station is a 10-15 minute walk from Pembroke College. There is a good taxi service from the station, and numerous buses go to St Aldates, stopping outside the college.

Coach/bus

National Express buses run to and from Oxford to locations throughout the UK. The Oxford Tube runs from London (Victoria, Marble Arch, Notting Hill Gate, Shepherd's Bush and Hillingdon) to Oxford every 10-30 minutes depending on time of day.

Air

If you have a choice, we recommend you fly to London Heathrow which is the most convenient for Oxford. The airline buses run regularly from London Heathrow (and London Gatwick) to Oxford. The bus stops in St Aldates, close to Pembroke.

Driving

Parking in Oxford is unfortunately difficult and expensive, and there is no parking available at the college. If you are driving, we strongly recommend using the park-and-ride.

Park-and-ride

There are several park-and-rides available on the outskirts of Oxford, so you are sure to find one no matter from which direction you have come. They are all clearly sign-posted, are linked to the centre of the city by regular bus services, and are open 24 hours per day (bus services run until about 11pm).

From Redbridge (south), Pear Tree (north), Seacourt (west) and Thornhill (east) the bus stops in St Aldates, very close to Pembroke.
